**In Rogue-Siskiyou National Forest** 

The McGrew Trail is the most famous 4x4 road in SW Oregon, located near Cave Junction, Oregon. It was part of the stage coach road from Jacksonville to Crescent City in the 1860's. It was closed by the National Forest to motor vehicles in 2016. MRA has recieved a special permit to ride into historic Sourdough Camp on Saturday July 29. Then camp on the Smith River and ride back out on Sunday. Supper, breakfast and camping gear transport will be provided by our sponsors. Come enjoy unusual vegetation, geology, cool clear swimming holes, 150 year old wagon wheel tracks, and good times.

The McGrew is about 20 miles each way and is mostly easy, except for two or three boulder sections that are very difficult. Vehicles can be dirt bike, quad, side-by-side, or jeep, however high clearance is necessary. Less experienced riders will have a hard time in the boulders. The ride will be self-guided due to the vast difference in the speed which different vehicles will travel. All vehicles and riders must be 100% legal, with quiet mufflers, spark arrestors, OHV tags, helmets, rider permits, and free of any dirt. There is a bail-out point where you can take an easier road, although some sections are for street legal vehicles only. Don't want to camp? No problem, ride Saturday only.

## Requirements:

- OHV Stickers
- 99db Spark Arrestors
- MRA Membership
- Donation to MRA's 2017 Land Acquisition Fund. Suggested donation \$100.
- Clean Dirt Free Motorcycle,
  Quad or SXS
- Rider Permits/License

## Things to know:

- Trail is approximately 20 miles each way. Make sure you have enough fuel to go the full distance.
- Camping will be supported with a truck to haul camping gear.
- Bring your own camping gear.
- Barbecue Saturday Night & Breakfast Sunday will be provided.
